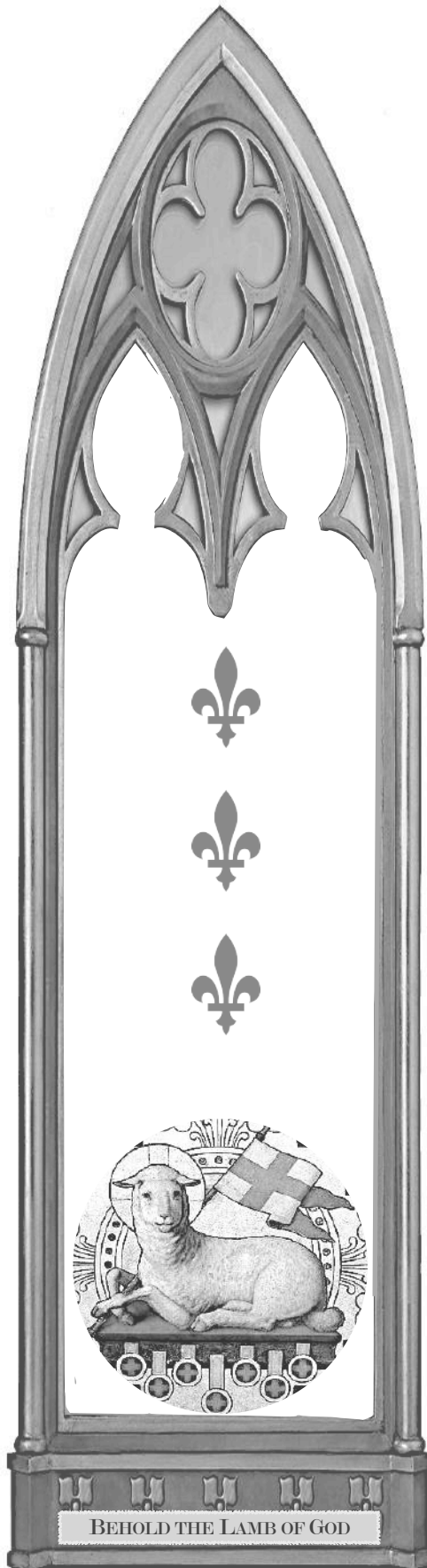

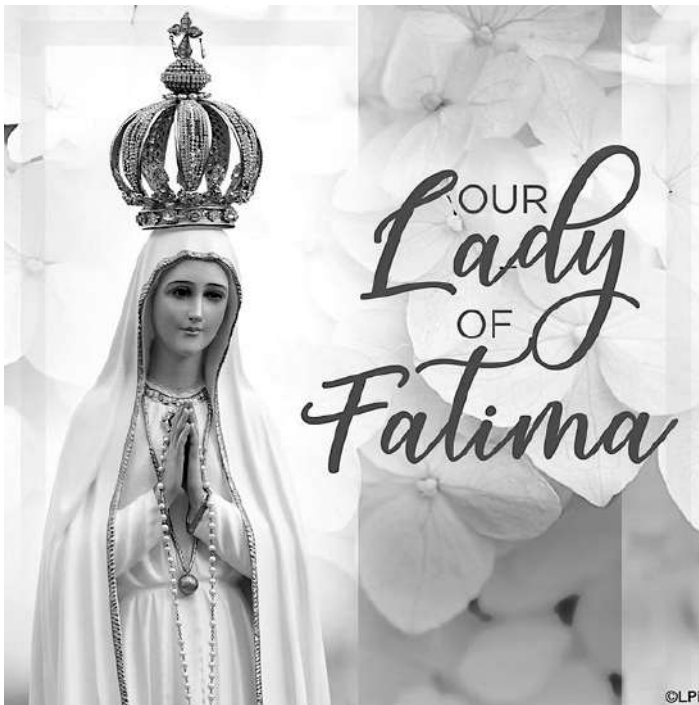
SPIRITUAL READING & REFLECTION

ALL FOR THE HONOR OF JESUS

Most Holy Father: More and more, day by day, a sense of gratitude expands within me for such abundant and splendid favors as granted me by Your Holiness. It is utterly impossible to express by word or by letter what a heart so full yearns to make known to Your Holiness. O exult, Holy Mother Church, who is given life not in vain by the outpouring of the blood of the Lord for the redemption of souls! Not least because in these remote regions of the known world the number of the faithful daily increases and is gathered before him who is the Rock upon whom the Church was built. Rejoice, Holy Father! Successor of Peter! I cry out again, Rejoice! The lambs of the Lord's flock are being multiplied greatly. Give thanks with us all to the Supreme Lord who is able to raise up children of Abraham even from the stones.

We have been able to complete a truly beautiful temple, considering these woodland regions, and a few days ago were able to dedicate it to the one Most High. Now the most pure Sacrifice is offered to Almighty God. Where five years ago the papacy and the Catholic religion were considered in parity with superstition and idolatry, now the truth of the Catholic faith is very freely and gloriously planted, received, and fructifies. The name of the Roman Pontiff, Leo XII, the common father of all the faithful, is familiar to the ears of almost everyone. His priceless gifts to the church of Cincinnati, brought together for public viewing, are admired, and a multitude, not only of the faithful but also of non-believers, observes and honors them. Those who very recently were estranged from our charity and our religious customs now pursue us with the highest praise and attend our sermons and services in such great number that the new edifice from time to time is incapable of accommodating them. The Search, on Formed.org, will be offered over a seven-week period—each session one hour+, in the social hall, led by Mary Hall.

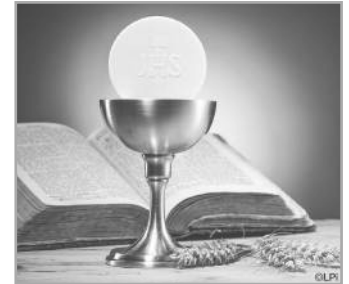
